CRITERIA SHEET FOR THE EAST WINDSOR LOCAL SCHOLARSHIPS USING COMMON APPLICATION

BROAD BROOK ANGLING CLUB/GARY WORMSTEDT MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

Eligibility

- 1. Applicant must be a resident of East Windsor.
- Applicant must be accepted by an accredited post-high school educational institution or technical school/ college.
- 3. Applicant may be presently enrolled in post-secondary education in an accredited educational institution.

BROAD BROOK SCHOLARSHIP FUND

Eligibility

- 1. Applicant must be a resident of East Windsor (does not have to be a current EWHS student).
- 2. Applicant must be enrolled or accepted into a college or continuing education program,

EAST WINDSOR EDUCATION ASSOCIATION AWARDS

Eligibility

- 1. Applicant must be a member of the senior class at East Windsor High School.
- 2. Applicant must be accepted by or enrolled in a post-secondary educational institution. 3. Applicant must be in the top 25% of his/her class.

EAST WINDSOR HIGH SCHOOL SCHOLARSHIPS

Eliaibility

- 1. Applicant must be a member of the senior class at East Windsor High School.
- 2. Applicant must be accepted by or enrolled in a post-high school educational institution.

EAST WINDSOR LIONS CLUB SCHOLARSHIPS

Eligibility

- 1. Applicant must be a resident of East Windsor.
- 2. Applicant must be a member of a current graduating class and the scholarship must be used no later than the second semester of the academic year.
- 3. Applicant must be accepted by an accredited institution of advanced learning.
- 4. Contact may be made by the committee regarding an appointment for a personal interview. 5. In addition to the Common Application, the student is to write a 250-500 word essay on his/her ability to think, reason and communicate his/her ideas about why they would benefit from receiving the Lions Scholarship. This will be a phase of the judges' evaluation process and a basic requirement for consideration.

EAST WINDSOR VETERANS COMMITTEE and AMERICAN LEGION BARRY POULTER POST #40

Eligibility

- 1. Applicants must be permanent, full time residents of East Windsor, Connecticut.
- 2. Applicants must be members of a current graduating class.
- 3. Applicants must have been accepted by an accredited, post-secondary institution of higher learning. 4. Applicants may be attending an accredited parochial school or trade school outside of East Windsor but must be East Windsor, Connecticut residents.

5. In addition to the Common Application, applicants must submit a short essay (200 words) about one of the following topics: Patriotism, July 4th, Significance of Veterans or Poppies.

MARGARET & ALVIN SYLVESTER-McKINLEY SCHOLARSHIPS

Eligibility

- 1. Applicant must be a member of the senior class at East Windsor High School.
- 2. Applicant must be in the top 25% of his/her class or have 5.0 GPA or better.
